PSI's Inside Technology, Media and Telecommunications (TMT)®

Curriculum Overview:

PSI's newly redesigned *Inside Technology, Media and Telecommunications*[®] curriculum is comprised of a series of courses focused on different aspects of the industry. The courses are designed to run on desktops, laptops and tablets (in landscape mode).

Learners are not required to complete the course in a specific order. Course "Complete" status is tiggered upon passing the final test (\geq 70%). If learners exit the course before completing the test, they must start the test from the beginning. The test does not save unfinished test results.

The courses are licensed for continuing education credits for CPAs licensed in the United States by the National Association of State Board of Accountancy (NASBA).

The course contains links to PSI's *Inside Technology, Media and Telecommunications* Wiki. The Wiki provides additional, up-to-date, detailed industry information not included in the course. Content contained in the Wiki is **not** included in the final test. Learners will need to register as a new user the first time they visit the wiki. After initially opening a Wiki link, future Wiki links may continue to open in the same browser window if that window remains open. Learners may need to navigate to that original window to view the content.
